Homebound Delivery Program Policy and Registration Form

- 1. The Morton-James Public Library has a homebound delivery program available to provide library materials to members living within the city limits of Nebraska City who are physically unable to visit the Library in person.
- 2. Members are eligible for this service if they are unable to leave their home due to surgery, illness, accident, or disability, and do not have a means of transportation.
- 3. Anyone interested in this service can contact the Library by phone for further information or to register. To participate in this program a library card is required.
- 4. Library staff and/or a designated volunteer will deliver and pickup library materials every two weeks.
- 5. A replacement fee will be assessed for lost, destroyed or damaged materials.
