

Movie Performance License Policy

The Morton-James Public Library is part of an agreement between the Nebraska Library Commission and Movie Licensing USA. The agreement permits free public performances of movies in public library buildings.

1. You do not need a library card to watch a movie.
2. Movies have to belong to the library collection.
3. Movies have to be covered by the Movie Licensing USA Public Library public performance licensing rights.
4. We only allow movies with MPAA ratings 'G', 'PG' & 'PG-13'.
5. The staff reserves the right to decline if staffing is limited or the movie would be disruptive for normal library operations.
6. Movies are shown on a first come, first served basis. We do not accept reservations for this service.
7. The movie must be turned off 15 minutes prior to closing time.
