Soon Mia and Pearl become more than tenants: all four Richardson children are drawn to the mother-daughter pair. But Mia carries with her a mysterious past and a disregard for the status quo that threatens to upend this carefully ordered community.

Origami artist, illustrator and author Linda Stephen presents "Illustrations in Origami" in November in the Kimmel Gallery inside the Morton-James Public Library in Nebraska City. This exhibit of more than 20 origami landscapes and cityscapes by Linda Stephen includes picture book illustrations and nationally award-winning artworks

The framed 3D wall art is created entirely from origami (folded paper) sculptures and layered washi handmade Japanese papers. Scenes include the art used for illustrating the origami picture book "The Day We Went to the Park", which won the 2021 Nebraska Book Award for Illustration.

Nationally award-winning paper artist Linda Stephen teaches origami and Japanese paper arts to ages 3 to 93. She is the illustrator and co-author of the picture book "The Day We Went to the Park", which won the 2021 Nebraska Book Award for Illustration.
